The objects listed and described below are unconditionally given, transferred, conveyed and assigned to the National Guard Militia Museum of New Jersey free and clear of any and all encumbrances, liens or other obligations:

1. The Donor warrants that he, she or it is the sole owner of all items listed in this agreement and had full legal authority over and ownership of these items. The Donor relinquishes all ownership of interest, including all rights, title, interest and possession of the item(s). Any intellectual property rights including copyright ownership, are also transferred.
2. The Donor holds the Museum, the New Jersey National Guard, the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, and the State of New Jersey harmless of any loss, damage or other basis of compensation of any item donated.
3. It is understood that objects donated to the National Guard Militia Museum of New Jersey may be photographed, sketched, filmed, videotaped, or reproduced without prior notice, and without any compensation expected from the National Guard Militia Museum of New Jersey.
4. The National Guard Militia Museum of New Jersey will have sole discretion and authority regarding when, how, where and if any and all items listed and described in this gift agreement are used, stored or displayed. There is no obligation created, either expressed or implied, to display or exhibit any item in any for any length of time. It is understood that only a small percentage of the museum's holdings can be publicly displayed at any given time.
5. It is further understood and agreed that the National Guard Militia Museum of New Jersey has the complete and unconditional right and discretion to dispose of any donated item(s) to any individual or organization, including the right to destroy or throw away anything received. Donated objects may be a common item, or the museum may have multiple items that are the same.

6. The gift and transfer of property does not entail the granting of any special concessions of privileges to the Donor, or the Donor’s executors/executrix, administrators, successors, heirs or assigns.

7. The Donor’s name, affiliation and address may be kept on file with the museum, and the Donor consents to the release of information.
